- 3. Any band may play up where time permits, include intention to play up on entry form and appropriate tune selection.
- 4. Grade 4B Will submit a selection of prescribed 4x2 parted Marches
- Grade 4A Will submit an M.S.R from the R.S.P.B.A list of prescribed tunes.
 Grade 3. Will submit a Medley 3-5 minutes
 Grade 2. Will submit an M.S.R.
- 6. Contest is scheduled to start at 2.00pm. (Time may change at promoter's discretion)
- 6 Any band may be asked to play for the Drum Major contest, failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- 7 <u>Band representative</u> is responsible for the band to be at the final tuning area. (Stewards are available to assist)
- 8 Bands <u>MUST</u> register at the RSPBA Officials point in the building adjacent to the swimming pool prior to the contest start time.
- 9 Bands failing to notify the Secretary or any official of the A, D&G Branch that they will not be participating in the contest before the start of the contest may be liable to a fine set by the RSPBA board of directors
- 10 All trophies <u>MUST</u> be returned to the promoter not less than one (1) month before the contest date or a fine of £50.00 for each trophy will be applied and suspension from all RSPBA events until the trophy is returned and the fine paid.
- 11 Coach Parking at Annan Academy. Car parking in adjacent swimming pool car park.
- 12 £100.00 will be paid to all visiting bands to help with their coach travel.
