1. Contest run under the rules of the Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association.
2. Closing Date. **27th July**. Late entries may be accepted however bands would be expected to play first. Draw will be made on **28th July 2024** and will be posted on the RSPBA website and the A, D&G branch Facebook page.
3. Any band may play up where time permits, include intention to play up on entry form and appropriate tune selection.
4. **Grade 4B** Will submit a selection of prescribed 4x2 **Marches**
5. **Grade 4A** Will submit an **MSR** set from the RSPBA list of prescribed tunes.
Grade 3. Will submit an **M.S.R.**
Grade 2. Will submit a **Medley** 4-6 minutes
Grade 1. Will submit an **M.S.R.**
